Deep morello cherry red in color. Full of red fruit, with hints of wild bramble, and subtle mineral and balsamic notes on the nose. Light touches of licorice create a lovely complexity. Good acidity on the palate, giving the wine a refreshing mouth feel. Soft rich, ripe tannins.

FOOD PAIRINGS

WINEMAKING

Until the fall, 2011 was a year with low rainfall. The temperature swings have been more drastic than usual. Due to high temperatures in August harvest started few weeks early.

BLEND

50% Syrah, 30% Tempranillo and 20% Merlot

ANALYSIS

Aging: Aged for 5 months in French and American Oak

Alcohol: 14.2%

TA: 5.6 g/l
